Official language


English is the official language of the Symposium. No simultaneous interpretation will be provided.

Location

The symposium will be located in Stará Lesná at the foot the Lomnický Štít massif in the eastern part of the High Tatras Mountains, about 2 km distance from the town Tatranská Lomnica. The hotel has the advantage of being located in a beautiful, natural setting while at the same time being easily accessible (by road, train, bus and airplane). Numerous excursions are possible: within the High Tatras National Park in which the hotel is situated, and to neighbouring areas such as the Belianske Tatry Mts., Kežmarok and Levoča (mediaeval towns), Vrbov (termal spa), Červený Kláštor (rafting on the river Dunajec), as well as to more distant ones, such as Prešov, Spiš Castle (UNESCO World Heritage) and Košice. The Polish part of the Tatra Mountains, centre at Zakopane, is also within easy reach.

Symposium participants are invited to take part in one-day coach excursion which will be held on October 7, 2006.
